TOTAL AMOUNT DUE:	SilverLakes Directors chairs will be awarded to the high point winner in each division at each show. A high point reserve prize will also be awarded. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded for each class for 1 st place through 5 th . Buckles will be awarded in each division at the final show for the high point in the series. You must show in at least 2 of the 3 shows.	
FOR OFFICE USE ONLY: AMOUNT PAID /	Class 1 and Class 12 will start at 9:00 a.m. in separate arenas, Trail classes will progress 12, 11, 10, 9 & so forth. Classes 1 through 8 will be in the main arena.	
PAYMENT METHOD:	Rules and Information: The point system for all classes will be as follows: 7 Points 1st, 5 Points 2nd, 4 points 3rd, 3 Points 4th, 2 Points 5th, and 1 point for competing as long as you were not disqualified. To be eligible for high point, you must enter each class in your division. This rule applies for daily high point and buckle series.	

SilverLakes Directors chairs will be awarded to the high point winner in each division at each
show. A high point reserve prize will also be awarded. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded for each class for 1 st place through 5 th . Buckles will be awarded in each division at the final show for the high point in the series. You must show in at least 2 of the 3 shows. No Dogs or Bikes will be allowed on the grounds.
Release forms will need to be completed before you will be given your exhibitor number. Release forms will be available at the show office.

Division Eligibility:

Novice Horse: Open to any horse that has **NOT** shown in any ranch riding or ranch trail in any association, club or horse show prior to January 2017.

Novice Rider: Open to any rider that has **NOT** shown in any ranch riding or ranch trail in any association, club or horse show prior to January 2017. SilverLakes high point series winner in the novice category will move to amateur. Entries may ride two-handed with any legal bridle.

Amateur: This division is open to all riders who have not shown, judged, trained or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, monetary or otherwise, either directly or indirectly, nor received remuneration for instructing another person in riding, driving, training or showing a horse for three calendar years prior to the current year.

Open: This division is open to all riders & horses.

Code of Conduct: All horses attending the event shall be treated humanely, with dignity, respect and compassion at all times.

AQHA Rules will be used to govern how each class will be shown and judged. AQHA equipment and schooling rules will also be in effect. Absolutely no abuse will be tolerated.

Please be on time for your run in your classes, 2 gait calls and you will be considered a no show and will forfeit fees.
