Rules and Information: The point system for all classes will be as follows: 7 Points 1st, 5 Points 2nd, 4 points 3rd, 3 Points 4th, 2 Points 5th, and 1 point for competing as long as you were not disqualified. To be eligible for high point, you must enter each class in your division. This rule applies for daily high point and buckle series.

Prizes will be awarded to the high point winner in each division at each show. A high point reserve prize will also be awarded.

Ribbons and prizes will be awarded for each class for 1st place through 6th.

Buckles will be awarded in each division at the final show for the high point in the series. You must show in at least 3 of the 4 shows.

No Dogs or Bikes will be allowed on the grounds.

Release forms will need to be completed before you will be given your exhibitor number. Release forms will be available at the show office.

Two arena's run simultaneously. Starting with class 1 in one arena & class 10 in a second arena.

The Ranch Trail class will be in another arena with class 10 starting first.

Class 1 and class 10 will start at the same time at 9:00 am.

Ranch Rail is after lunch starting with class 11

Division Eligibility:

Youth 17 & Under: Anyone 17 and under may enter this category.

Novice Horse & Novice Rider: Open to any horse or rider that has ****NOT**** shown in any ranch riding or ranch trail in any association, club or horse show prior to January 2017. Novice Rider and Novice Horse are eligible if they have shown less than two years.

SilverLakes high point series winners are not eligible in the novice category and will move to amateur.

Entries may ride two-handed with any legal bridle. Novice Riders can show in a snaffle bit and can ride with two hands. All legal bits must be ridden with one hand.

Amateur: This division is open to all riders who have not shown, judged, trained or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, monetary or otherwise, either directly or indirectly, nor received remuneration for instructing another person in riding, driving, training or showing a horse for three calendar years prior to the current year.

Open: This division is open to all riders & horses.

Amateur and Open: A junior horse (5 years and under) maybe shown with a hackamore or a snaffle, with one or two hands. Any legal bit must be ridden one handed.

AQHA Rules will be used to govern how each class will be shown and judged. AQHA equipment and schooling rules will also be in effect. Absolutely no abuse will be tolerated. Hat or helmet, boots and a buttoned long sleeve shirt are required.

Please be on time for your run in your classes, 2 gate calls and you will be considered a no show and will forfeit fees.
